Program description: Mahamudra, the jewel of the Kagyu Lineage, is a form of meditation that explores the timeless clarity of mind pervading all phenomena. Practitioners can experience boundless emptiness and wisdom, inseparable from each other. Mahamudra can be divided into four distinct phases, known as the Four Yogas of Mahamudra: 1. One-pointedness; 2. Simplicity; 3. One taste; 4. Non-meditation. Join us as Shamar Rinpoche introduces this deep and profound practice. Teachings on this subject will be followed by the Vajrasattva Empowerment.

Biography of Lama Jigme Rinpoche: Lama Jigme Rinpoche, older brother to the late 14th Shamarpa, is the representative for H.H. the 17th Karmapa Trinley Thaye Dorje in Europe. He is also the spiritual authority for Dhagpo Kagyu Ling in France, an important seat of Dharma activity for the Karmapa.

Born in Kham, Eastern Tibet, in 1949, Jigme Rinpoche accompanied H.H. the 16th Karmapa to Rumtek, Sikkim, where the His Holiness founded a monastery to preserve the Karma Kagyu teachings. Jigme Rinpoche, along with the tulkus gathered at Rumtek, received lineage transmissions directly from H.H. Karmapa. In addition, Rinpoche received many teachings and initiations from Gendün Rinpoche, Pawo Rinpoche, Kalu Rinpoche and Dilgo Kyentse Rinpoche, as well other revered masters.

When the 16th Karmapa appointed Lama Jigme Rinpoche as his European representative, he said: "In the person of Lama Jigme Rinpoche, I leave you my heart." It is in this spirit that Jigmela continues his activity, teaching and inspiring all who come in contact with him.

Biography of Karma Trinlay Rinpoche: Born in France to an American mother and French father, at the age of three, Trinlay Rinpoche was recognized as the reincarnation of an important Buddhist teacher by the 16th Karmapa and began his monastic training with Kalu Rinpoche shortly thereafter. He is one of the first Westerners to have received and completed the traditional Tibetan Buddhist education offered to Tulkus, or reincarnate masters. Rinpoche has also pursued Western academic studies in philosophy, history and philology. He currently lives in Paris with his wife and divides his time among studies, teaching, and translating.

2. Practice:

Mahamudra Practice

A Practical Application of Shamar Rinpoche's Teaching Led by Dharma Teacher Tsony August 18 (evening) to 23, 2014

Based on the preceding teaching, Dharma Teacher Tsony will lead a 5-day retreat, which will explore the stages of Mahamudra practice. This program is a perfect opportunity to deepen understanding of Rinpoche's teaching through practice.

Dharma Teacher Tsony: A Buddhist monk for over 25 years, Tsony completed two traditional 3-year retreats under the guidance of the great meditation master Gendun Rinpoche. For 15 years, he was Abbot of Kundrel Ling Monastery in France. Since 1991, he has been teaching philosophy and meditation throughout Europe and the U.S. He is now the resident teacher at Bodhi Path Natural Bridge.

Airports and Ground Transportation

All airports require renting a car, limo service or ride sharing to get to the center. Ride sharing information will be sent out with confirmation of registration.

Roanoke, Virginia, about 45 miles away, is the closest airport. Car rental or limo service available. Limo Services: Roanoke Airport Transportation Service, 540-345-7710, and Prestige Limousine, Inc., 540-342-8049. Price depends on number of people traveling together. Call for pricing. Make arrangements early to insure availability.

Lynchburg, Virginia, is a regional airport about one and a half hours away. This airport is often cheapest for those flying from the west. You will need a rental car from this airport. **Washington**, **DC** airports, Dulles International or Reagan International, about 200 and 210 miles away, respectively. You will need a rental car if you fly into either of these airports. **Baltimore** International Airport, about 240 miles away. You will need a rental car from this airport. **A special deal:** For folks coming from Florida or points south, check Allegiant Air's website for very cheap flights directly into Roanoke. From New York City, Delta Airlines has a \$150 round trip ticket to Lewisburg, West Virginia, which is a 1.5-hour drive away.
